A copy of your insurance must be submitted to Castleconnell Campsite at time of booking. Unfortunately, we cannot accept any bookings without proof of insurance.
- Adhere to all COVID guidelines. COVID-19 signage is in place throughout the campsite and social distancing guidelines apply.
- Castleconnell Campsite have conducted a risk assessment of the campsite. We wish to draw your attention to the following risks:
 - water drains throughout the campsite are not fenced off.
 - Cars are parked at owners risk.



CAMPSITE RULES

1. The campsite cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage to personal property.
2. Vehicles including trailers 4X4 ATV's are not permitted on camping fields.
3. When using the obstacle course all youth members are to be supervised by an ADULT at all times. The obstacle course must be used as intended.
4. Small fires are permitted in the forest for backwoods cooking if lit on a fire blanket.
5. No felling of trees, there is plenty on the ground for all your needs.
6. Put your "LEAVE NO TRACE" into action and bring home your rubbish. Recycle where possible.
7. No fires allowed on the camping fields.
8. Kitchenette – Please leave it as you found it.
9. Toilet Block – Please leave them as you would like to find them.
10. There is no access to the forest at the far side of the railway track without prior permission from a member of the Campsite Staff.
11. Please pitch on your allocated pitch number.
12. Quiet time from midnight to 8 a.m.
13. For safety reasons there is no parking on the roadside in front of the Campsite.
14. No ALCOHOL is permitted on the Campsite.
15. The most important rule of the Campsite is to enjoy your stay.
